IMPORTANT TSES INFORMATION:

PARCC (Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers) Assessments will be given to all students in grades 3, 4 and 5 this Spring. Although this is a standardized assessment, the test items are aligned with the instruction and assessment that has taken

place during the school year. Your child's scores on this test are helpful to our understanding of your child's areas of strength and the areas in need of support as we plan for his or her instruction for the upcoming school year. Please ensure that your child is well rested and at school (on time) for the dates listed below. Please note that the list is in grade order, NOT in date order.

Grade 3: *English Language Arts May 9, May 10 and May 11 (8:45-10:45)*

Math: May 22, May 23, May 24 and May 25 (8:45-10:45)

Artist of the Week~London W.~Grade 2~“Penguin Print”~Medium: Printing Ink

Students in second grade were introduced to the Emperor and Adele penguins of Antarctica, listening to the stories “Where is Home, Little Pip?” and “Without You”, and watching videos of penguins in Antarctica during Art. Second grade learned how to draw penguins by combining basic shapes such as circles, ovals and triangles. Printmaking is a technique used by artists to create multiple copies of their artwork. Second grade learned that relief printmaking is a process of

carving or etching into to the surface so that areas that are raised are the areas that are inked. London drew her penguin onto a sheet of scratch foam, pressing into the surface to create the "valleys" where the printing ink would not fill. She rolled the ink onto the surface of her printing plate with a rubber brayer and then laid their paper over top the inked surface. Using her fingers, she "burnished" the back of the paper, picking up the ink from the printing plate. When her print was dry, London used a little bit of "magic" crayons to add vibrant color. Excellent, London!
