I urge to do this as quickly as possible-if not today, please do it before the end of the first week of school!

This year, the charge for school lunch is \$2.75 and the cost of milk not purchased as part of the school lunch is \$0.50. Please make every attempt to ensure that your child's point of sale account has funds! If we loan your child funds for lunch, please re-pay us as soon as possible. If there is any chance that you might qualify, please complete the Free and Reduced Meal Application as soon as possible and return according to the directions on the form. TSES will be sending home a copy of the school newsletter. In addition, this newsletter will be sent out via School Messenger (HCPSS email) and will be available on the school website. I recommend that you log into http://www.hcpss.org/hcpss-news/ and OPT IN to the emergency text message feature. This is a very useful service particularly in the event of a school emergency or unexpected change in plans for the school day. TSES can not call every parent individually if there is a school wide emergency.
