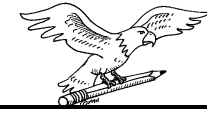

(Math) • The number of FARM students who meet the HCPSS cut score for Math MAP will increase from 29.8 % to 38.3%. (Math) • The number of students overall who meet the Fountas & Pinnell Benchmark grade level expectations will increase from 81.2% to 85%. (Literacy) • The number of FARMS students who meet the Fountas & Pinnell Benchmark grade level expectations will increase from 70.6% to 76.6%. (Literacy) | |
