Talbott Springs Families,

It has been a wonderful week at TSES! We appreciate your patience and flexibility as we work through the arrival and dismissal process. The car drop off and pick up area will remain congested due to the complications presented by the construction of our replacement school projected to open for the 2022-2023 school year. We are moving cars and students through this area as quickly as possible while attending to the safety of all those in the area. For those walking to the school please do not walk across either the bus loop or the car loop. Please remain on the sidewalk until you reach the school building. Please see this link for visuals.

Related Arts classes (Art, Music, Physical Education, Technology and Media) take place on a 'color day rotation'. Historically, students were assigned Related Arts based on the day of the week, for example, Tuesday might be Media class for your child. The color day rotation means that your child might have Media on an Orange day which is not always on a Tuesday. With the 5-day color rotation, the colors occur in a specific sequence even if there are days off in between. Please look at the calendar at this link to better visualize the pattern of days. The importance of the color day rotation is that your child is provided with a more balanced Related Arts instructional program. When students have a class such as art every Monday, and school has scheduled closings for few Mondays off during a quarter, Art instruction is compromised. If Art is on a Green day, we can assure a more balanced offering of Art through each quarter. The complication of the Related Arts color schedule is that it students and families need to be aware of their child(ren)'s color days for Physical Education so that sneakers/tennis shoes are worn for safety during PE.

Please remember that there is no school on Monday and Tuesday next week. We look forward to seeing your children on Wednesday September 8! Face Masks/Face Coverings: All persons entering TSES must be wearing a face covering that meets the guidelines set by the CDC. Also, please reinforce to your child that he or she may not touch the mask of another student for any reason. Please consider sending a second mask in your child's backpack. As per the current HCPSS safety guidelines, band students will be provided with special masks that allow them to play in class without their face being uncovered, using mask-like bell covers on all instruments, and distancing to the greatest extent possible (including playing outside when able) during class times to protect students from contracting and spreading COVID-19. Chorus students will be wearing masks and distancing to the greatest extent possible during rehearsals.
