## Apply Now for Prekindergarten for the Current 2022-23 School Year

HCPSS is currently accepting <u>applications</u> for enrollment in its half-day and full-day prekindergarten programs for the current school year. Children must have turned four by Sept. 1, 2022, to be considered for enrollment. All families who meet first-priority criteria (outlined in the application) will be granted enrollment. As space allows, families with household incomes up to 300% of the <u>Federal Poverty Level</u> or who meet other second priority criteria may be enrolled. Pre-K applications for the 2023-2024 school year will be available in March.
