INFORMATION FOR TSES FAMILIES:

January 2021 Meal Service Adjustments: With schools being closed for students on Friday, January 29, families who pre-order or walk-up for Grab-and-Go meals on Thursday, January 28 will receive meals for Thursday through Sunday. Meals are free of charge for all students and any child under age 18. All meals include breakfast, lunch, snacks and dinner. Please visit this <u>link</u> for additional information.

HCPSS COVID-19 Dashboard: <u>The HCPSS COVID-19 Dashboard</u> now includes a link to <u>Board</u> <u>of Education Health Metrics</u> as well as three weeks of Howard County 7 day average positivity rates and 7-day average confirmed cases per 100,000 people.

Upcoming MAP Administration: On both Wednesday February 3rd and Wednesday February 10th, students in grades 1-5 will take the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessment. The data from the MAP assessment will help schools and teachers measure your child's academic progress. The MAP test does not affect report card grades. The difficulty of each test item adjusts depending on how your child responds. It is normal for students to only answer about half the questions correctly. The Math MAP test will be offered on February 10th from 9-11 am. If your child is unable to attend, makeup testing will be offered during asynchronous learning times. Teachers will share Google Meet information as we get closer to the February dates.

Howard County Library System has recently updated it's branches with the equipment needed to provide outdoor Wi-Fi to the public. It is currently available at the Central, East Columbia, Elkridge, and Savage Branches. Only Glenwood and Miller do not have it yet, though they will at some point.
