Please note, MSDE requires that Pre-K be made available first to students who meet first-priority criteria. When space allows, families that meet second priority criteria will be considered. **A Message from the TSES Health Room Staff**: If your child has any of the following, please keep your child home. You are welcome to call the school to talk with one of our nurses at 410-313-6915 if you are unsure of whether or not to send your child to school. We are aware that some of the symptoms in the second category can mimic seasonal allergies or illnesses other than COVID.

- 1 of the following symptoms:
  - o New onset cough, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing
  - New loss of taste or smell

### OR

- 2 of the following:
  - o Fever over 100.4 or chills within the past 24 hours
  - Fatigue
  - o Muscle or body aches
  - o Headache
  - Sore throat
  - o Congestion or runny nose
  - Chills or shaking chills;
  - Nausea or vomiting;
  - o Diarrhea
