2021-2022 Digital Education Center: The Howard County Public School System is planning for a full-time online option for students entering grades K-12 who wish to learn virtually for the 2021-2022 school year. Parents/guardians who wish to commit to the DEC should log in to HCPSS Connect Synergy by **Wednesday, May 5 at 4 p.m.** (see directions below). Families **must commit to the DEC for the full 2021-2022 school year**. Students who wish to return to in-person learning during the 2021-2022 school year, if that option is available, should not sign up for the DEC. The Superintendent and Board of Education members have stressed that they consider the return to normalized, five-day, in-person learning this fall to be essential for the majority of HCPSS students, however, an official decision on the 2021-2022 academic year has not yet been made. In committing to the DEC, parents/guardians acknowledge that:

- This is a commitment that your child will attend the DEC for the 2021-2022 school year, and that students will need to go through the reassignment process if they choose to return to their home school for instruction.
- Not all course requests may be able to be honored in the DEC environment.
- There are attendance requirements that will apply in the DEC environment.

• The implementation of the DEC is pending funding from the HCPSS Board of Education. Should funding not be provided, students automatically will be returned to their assigned home school.

Prior to making any decision, we strongly encourage families to review <u>details about the DEC</u> that are available online, as well as answers to frequently asked questions for the <u>DEC in general</u> and <u>student-specific information</u>. To access the commitment form:

- 1. <u>Log in to HCPSS Connect Synergy</u> using parent/guardian credentials
- 2. Select More Options from the left panel
- 3. Select Digital Education Center Commitment from the middle of the page
- 4. Complete the questions in the form for each child and select "save"
- 5. Email <u>DEC@hcpss.org</u> with any questions about the Digital Education Center. If you need assistance completing the online commitment form, please contact your child's school.

Consent for Voluntary Student COVID-19 Testing: HCPSS now offers a voluntary K-12 COVID-19 Testing Program that will provide free COVID-19 tests for students and school-based staff who develop COVID-like symptoms or are <u>identified as close contacts</u> while they are in a school building. Parents/guardians should not send their children to school, and staff should not report to work if they are presenting COVID-like symptoms

<u>Answers to frequently asked questions</u> about the COVID-19 Testing Program are available online.
