Last Day of School for TSES Students: Please see the TSES School Messenger alert from Tuesday April 26, 2022. The last day of school for TSES students will be on Tuesday June 14. We will be closing three days earlier than HCPSS schools due to the construction projects that are planned for this summer. We will start the 2022-2023 school year in the TSES Replacement School which is being built next to our current building.

MCAP: During the month of May, TSES students in grades 3, 4 and 5 will be participating in the Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP).

What is MCAP? The Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP) provides information to educators, parents and the public on student progress towards proficiency on the Maryland College and Career Ready Standards. Through a strong assessment system, stakeholders gain an understanding of how schools are performing and where assistance can be directed to support student growth and achievement. The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires that states administer annual statewide assessments to all students in English Language Arts/Literacy and Mathematics in grades 3-8 and once in high school.

When are Talbott Springs Elementary students in grades 3-5 testing?

Rather than asking our students to sit through long periods of testing, we are administering the assessments in smaller parts during AM and PM sessions each lasting up to an hour.

Tuesday May 10 and Wednesday May 11: AM and PM sessions

Monday May 16 and Tuesday May 17: AM and PM sessions

How can I assure that my child is prepared for testing? We encourage students to get a good night's sleep and eat breakfast either at home or at school.
