MCAP: During the month of May, TSES students in grades 3, 4 and 5 will be participating in the Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP). *What is MCAP?* The Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP) provides information to educators, parents and the public on student progress towards proficiency on the Maryland College and Career Ready Standards. The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires that states administer annual

statewide assessments to all students in English Language Arts/Literacy and Mathematics in grades 3-8 and once in high school.

When are Talbott Springs Elementary students in grades 3-5 testing?

Rather than asking our students to sit through long periods of testing, we are administering the assessments in smaller parts during AM sessions each lasting up to an hour

vaccine and must be 18 or younger. Parent or legal guardian required to give consent for anyone younger than 18. No advance registration needed, we'll just do paper consent and admin forms on-site.
