If you have a moment to drive or walk by TSES this weekend, please do so! TSES Replacement Building construction is moving along quickly! The classrooms will be in the two story section in the back of the building. The front of the building has the cafeteria, music rooms, gym and office area. We are working with Dustin Construction Company and HCPSS to assure ways that our students and staff are involved with the building project when our students return to our current building for the 2021-2022 school year. The projected completion date of the TSES Replacement School is the summer of 2022. Our first year in the new building will be the 2022-2023 school year.

A week ago, in a message sent to the HCPSS Community, we learned that the school system will no longer require masks to be worn outdoors while on school property, other than at athletic contests. This includes outdoor recess, eating school meals outdoors, physical education classes, and other times when students, staff and/or visitors are outside on school grounds. Masks may still be worn based on individual discretion, and social distancing during these times continues to be strongly encouraged to the extent possible. Masks will also continue to be required inside schools based on the State's orders.

With only a few weeks left to the school year, we continue to teach students new content in each subject! Please assure that your children log in daily if they are virtual or hybrid students or that they come to school on their assigned days. Please encourage your child to finish the school year STRONG! Thank you to each of our families for your continued effort to assure that TSES students are connected to one another, to the adults at school and to the learning. Have a wonderful weekend!

#### **Information Items:**

**Carpool Loop Safety**: Although we are approaching the end of the school year, we have recently welcomed additional students back to in-person learning at TSES. Many of our students and families are back on school grounds for the first time in several months and are using the new car loop for arrival and dismissal. Use of the car drop off and pick up loop will require patience until the TSES Replacement Building is completed in the summer of 2022. We appreciate your understanding! To ensure the safety of our students and staff, please adhere to the following safety rules for the car loop:

- Please maintain one-way traffic
- Please remain in your car (unless putting child into a car seat)
- Please do not pass another car without staff direction.
- At dismissal, please inform staff of your child(ren)'s name(s). A staff member will escort your child(ren) to your car.
- It is helpful if your child enters and exits your car from the passenger side. We understand that many children are in car seats or booster seats making this a challenge.
- Please follow directions of staff.
- Children not picked up in the car loop by 3:40 (11:40 on Wednesdays) will be brought to the front office and parents will be contacted for pick-up

  delegate is not in attendance) is entitled to make motions, debate and vote at each PTACHC
  meeting.
- Take careful notes of announcements and the program at the PTACHC meeting.
- Vote on PTACHC motions as directed by TSES PTA unless authorized by TSES PTA to use your own judgment. It is preferable for delegates to ascertain TSES PTA opinion prior to voting. However, when time does not permit or consultation, a delegate must vote their conscience utilizing their own experience and good judgment.
- Post announcements of PTACHC activities in the TSES PTA's bulletin or newsletter.
