2022-2023 School Meals (ACTION ITEM) The determination of a student's ability to receive free lunch each day is determined through the FARM Application process. Not all students will receive free lunch for the 2022-2023 school year. For families who do not qualify or who do not complete the FARM Application will be charged \$2.80 per lunch Please note that all students at TSES may receive a free breakfast. Families are urged to check their eligibility and complete a FARMS application as soon as possible. Families must submit a

HCPSS Policy 8080: Response use of Technology, Digital Tools and Social Media: The purpose of this policy is to define expectations for individuals regarding the responsible use of technology, digital tools and social media for HCPSS sponsored programs. This policy has been reviewed with all of our students in Kindergarten through Grade 5 to assure understanding the responsibilities of students. This policy was also addressed during our Back to School Nights. Highlights for students:

- Do not share user names and passwords with other students. If two different students are assigned to the same computer, each will have his or her own unique user name and password.
- Stay on the websites that are part of the instruction. Searches of other sites can be tracked by HCPSS when a child has a pattern of not clicking on non-instructional sites. Most sites are blocked, however, occasionally, one may not be blocked.
- At the elementary school level, student personal cell phones must be off and in backpacks during the school day which includes the bus ride to and from school.
- Parents should monitor their child's use of social media sites. At times, these sites have been used to bully other students by the intentional posting of information to cause social or emotional damage.
 Policy 8080 crosses Policy 1060 in this area for the purposes of investigating these incidents and following the guidelines of the Student Code of Conduct.

From the TSES Health Room and School Based Wellness Center: We are excited to announce that we have our School Based Wellness Center (SBWC) up and running at Talbott Springs Elementary!

- Here is some information that you might not know:
- School-Based Wellness Centers (Nurse Practitioners) will bill Medical Assistance only for in-person visits. There are **NO** copays or bills for uncovered charges.
- Telemedicine Visits are NOT billed unless a student sees their own medical provider via Telemedicine.
 Klebanow & Associates and Columbia Medical Practice use the Telemedicine platform to see their
 own patients and bill these visits the same as an office visit. If your child has a different medical
 provider, your child will see a Columbia Medical Practice provider, but you will NOT be charted any
 co-pays or fees. If your child has health insurance and the insurer only pays part of the bill, you
 will NOT be responsible for any unpaid balance.
