## Information:

**Bus loop and Carpool loop:** Each day TSES staff members are doing their best at both arrival and dismissal time to assure the safety of each of our students. We also understand that your time is important and we are moving students and traffic through as quickly as possible. On a typical morning, we can get all 500 students in the building in under 15 minutes that includes bus riders, walkers, daycare van riders and car riders. Rainy days provide additional challenges, and the flow of traffic and students moves more slowly. This information is being shared again because we recently had incidents that put the lives of staff members and students in danger. We are asking for your continued support and patience with the following:

- Please drive slowly and carefully through the TSES parking lot when dropping off your child or when pulling out of a parking spot.
- Please do not pull into the bus loop to drop off or pick up your child between 8:20 and 9:00 or 2:45-3:45. The area is marked for buses and staff members.
- When entering or exiting the parking lot, please follow the directions of the crossing guard and the staff members who are assisting with directing traffic. Do not bypass the directions of the crossing guard or the staff members to drop off children in the bus loop.

We appreciate those who are already following these guidelines and who are exercising kindness to our staff members who are on arrival and dismissal duties.

**COVID Booster Vaccines at TSES:** On December 7, 2022, Our School-Based Wellness Center will offer free COVID bivalent booster vaccines for children ages 5 through 11 years of age who have received their primary COVID series two months ago or longer.

**Parents of TSES 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Graders! CogAT (Cognitive Abilities Test):** This year, the Howard County Public School System will be administering the CogAT to all students in grades 3 and 5. The CogAT is a group-administered abilities test that measures students' reasoning abilities, which they develop through in-school and out-of-school experiences. It is not designed to test a student's academic achievement, but their potential.

The test is made of three parts – Verbal, Quantitative, and Nonverbal. Each part takes approximately 30 minutes to complete. The CogAT helps educators understand a student's cognitive strengths and weaknesses and assists with adapting instruction to meet the needs and abilities of each student.

All students in Grades 3 and 5 will participate in the testing. The CogAT will be administered on December 6, 7, 8. No special preparation is required. Just send your child to school ready to learn as you do daily.

The HCPSS/TSES Gifted and Talented Education Program will use the data from the CogAT as one criterion for placement into fourth grade Gifted/Talented mathematics classes and middle school Gifted/Talented content classes. Students' individual scores will be reported to parents in late February/early March. Please contact Dr. Derek Lewis with questions.
