**Vaccination Expectations for Volunteers:** All volunteers who enter HCPSS buildings to interact with students must provide <u>must provide proof of vaccination status or a negative</u> <u>COVID-19 test</u>. Parents and other visitors who <u>enter schools for a brief visit</u> are not required to shoe proof of vaccination or testing. All parents, visitors and volunteers are <u>required to be</u> <u>masked</u> regardless of their vaccination status.

**HCPSS/TSES Chromebook Obligations:** Beginning on Monday September 13, 2021, HCPSS will charged families for lost, stolen or damaged devices under the following circumstances:

- Families will be charged for any devices that are lost, stolen or damaged while in their care.
- If devices are lost, stolen or damaged during school hours and in our school building, school administrators will conduct an investigation to determine if the incident was the result of neglect on the part of the student assigned to the device.
