We are so grateful to have had a full week of school! TSES staff members are so energized by the positive spirit and eagerness that your children bring to our school. Please continue to be vigilant about your child's health status as we work in community to support of the health of each of our members. If you are unsure about your child's health status, please contact our nursing staff, Mrs. DeLair and Ms. Byrd to ask questions. In the week ahead, during our Social Emotional Learning time, your child(ren) will learn about the meaning of 'quarantine', how it might feel to be in quarantine and what it feels like to return to school after quarantine. The introductory video about quarantine shows 'Jennifer' (Mrs. Sansone) interacting with 'Nurse Smiley' (Dr. Roth) as 'Jennifer' learns that reporting sickness is OK and being in quarantine, whether you are sick or not sick, is OK. Although it is not my wish to have ANY child in quarantine, we do want our children to be emotionally prepared. 'Jennifer' and 'Nurse Smiley' also discuss the importance children coming to school when they are healthy. This past weekend, air purifiers were installed in each of our classroom areas adding to the protections of upgraded air filters and our masking, handwashing and hand sanitizing practices. If your child placed in quarantine by the school, we will be in contact with you regarding the process of accessing work and meeting times with teachers. Because quarantine is an absence from school, we are unable to require that school work be completed, however, it is helpful for children to be able to engage in work during their absences.

HCPSS/TSES Chromebook Obligations: On Monday September 13, 2021, HCPSS started charging families for lost, stolen or damaged devices under the following circumstances. Please note that when your child's Chromebook is damaged, we are required to investigate the circumstances surrounding the damage. Please assure that your child has brought his/her Chromebook back to TSES. Several children have returned the Chromebook that belongs to a sibling.

- Families will be charged for any devices that are lost, stolen or damaged while in their care.
- If devices are lost, stolen or damaged during school hours and in our school building, school administrators will conduct an investigation to determine if the incident was the result of neglect on the part of the student assigned to the device.
