**HCPSS Virtual Instruction Supports:** Occasionally, students may have issues with Canvas, Google Meet or other learning platforms used by HCPSS. If your child is having difficulty please use the resources below to problem solve.

- K-5 Students begin on September 8, 2020; Pre-K students begin on September 10, 2020
- STUDENTS LOG INTO THEIR MORNING CLASS at 9:00. Grades K, 2 and 4 log into their Math class. Grades 1, 3 and 5 log into their ELA class.
- <u>Elementary School Student Day is from 9:00-3:50. Please use this link to access student schedules</u>. There are some similarities across the day for each grade level and there are some differences. Please note that the PK schedule is different from each of the other grade levels.
- Teacher Assignments, LexiaCore and Dreambox will be completed during asynchronous learning times. The amount of LexiaCore and Dreambox time is greatly reduced from the spring 2020.
