**CogAT: Cognitive Test of Abilities:** CogAT is an assessment that is used as one point of data as we work together to determine placement for students in Grade 4 GT Math and Grade 6 Math, English, Social Studies and Science GT classes. CogAT is a multiple-choice assessment that measures reasoning skills with different types of verbal, quantitative, and nonverbal questions. Per HCPSS protocol, CogAT will be given to all students in grades 3 and 5 on the dates outlined below. Each of the three testing sessions is approximately an hour long.

**Calling TSES Young Authors!** Young Authors' Contest Entries are due on Monday, December 2, 2019. Students in grades 1-5 can submit an original poem and/or a short story for the contest. Information is found at this <u>link</u>. All entries must include the following:

- Entries be original work using a 12-point font.
- The short stories must range between 100-400 words (Grades 1 and 2) and 300-800 words (Grades 3-5).
- The poems can be any style and must range between 25-150 words for all grade levels.
- Entries must not include graphics.
