Target: Literacy

Statement of Commitment: We commit to ensuring that all students have access to high quality instruction through differentiation based on grade level reading standards. As a staff, we will engage in a variety of professional learning in relation to the grade level reading standards.

Strategies:

- Staff will provide quality first instruction while developing differentiated approaches to meet the needs of ALL students.
- Structured time is provided for teachers and support staff to engage in collaborative discussion and planning in support of the inclusion of grade level standards through first instruction and differentiation of instruction.
- 3. K-5: Monthly Literacy Coach led data meetings to identify instructional areas for reteaching or review for individual students or groups of students to inform teachers of instructional adjustments.

Target: Math

Statement of Commitment: TSES Staff commit to the development and application of flexibility and structural changes within the math instructional block based to increase student-to-student discourse and concept appropriate intervention and enrichment.

Strategies:

- 1. Instructional staff will participate in balanced and intentional observational opportunities and teacher-led goal-setting dialogues with students.
- 2. Instructional staff will engage in Math Coach led professional learning to support best practices in incorporating student-to-student discourse.
- 3. Instructional staff will engage in regularly scheduled collaborative math planning.
